<p>Bachelor or Master unibz students apply in this call for a Study Mobility:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • within the Erasmus+, Bilateral Agreements or Swiss Mobility programmes • to take place in the first and/or second semester 2025/26 • to be completed by 31 December 2026
<p>Benefits for Exchange Mobility Winners:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mobility financial grant • Exemption from host university tuition fees • Access to partner's campus services, language courses, etc. • Recognition of activities by unibz
<p>Erasmus+ Study Mobility:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Promoted and funded by the EU • Partner universities abroad with an interinstitutional agreement with unibz • Monthly EU contribution based on destination's living cost (from 350 to 400 Euro) • Additional flat-rate semester contribution from unibz (500 Euro) • Financial top-ups for travel to the destination country and for disadvantaged conditions
<p>Bilateral Agreements:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicable to non-Erasmus area or Italian universities with an interinstitutional agreement with unibz • Promoted and funded by unibz • Semester lump sum based on destination location (from 1,750 to 2,750 Euro)

<p>Swiss Mobility Programme:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Universities in Switzerland with an interinstitutional agreement with unibz • Financing by Swiss universities (approx. 400 Euro per month) • Additional flat-rate semester contribution from unibz (500 Euro)
<p>Requirements for Admission:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not enrolled beyond regular degree duration (i.e. mobile students cannot be “fuori corso” in 2025/26) • Language proficiency for German/English/Italian: B1 level, registered in the student’s career by the deadline of the call, in the language(s) of instruction of the partner university • Language proficiency for B1 in French/Spanish/Portuguese: recognised language certificates or computer-based test at the unibz Language Centre on 19 February 2025, 4 pm (registration by 12 February 2025 > language.certification@unibz.it)
<p>Submission of Application Form:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online application by 3 March 2025, 12 noon • Max. two partner universities in order of preference from those available for the student’s study programme only • Design students only: PDF portfolio to be sent to elena.ghizzo@unibz.it by the deadline of the call • Incomplete or not submitted applications will be void/not considered
<p>Selection and Acceptance Process:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluation based on credits, mark average and motivation/study project • Faculty Committee rankings published by 25 March 25 2025 • Winners must confirm acceptance • Residual places offered based on general ranking
<p>Responsibility of Winners:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fulfill administrative requirements/deadlines of partner universities • Prepare Learning Agreement and sign financial contract • Renew enrollment at unibz for 2025/26 • Stay informed about destination country context and risks!
