Short mobilities and BIPs (Blended Intensive Programmes) are one of the new and innovative formats of student mobility introduced by the new Erasmus+ 2021-2027 Programme. These programmes, jointly developed by multiple higher education institutions, feature advanced and innovative pedagogical approaches that combine short-term face-to-face (physical) mobilities with portions of virtual learning.

These short mobilities are inherently transnational and transdisciplinary, as curricula are developed and taught together by partner institutions in different countries. The combination of in-person and virtual learning spaces allows students and professors to experience and exchange highly collaborative, challenge-based, and research-steeped methods of teaching and learning.

Through the required virtual part of the programme, students can develop and hone their digital knowledge and skills, reflecting the European Commission's priority to harness the potential of digital technologies for teaching and learning and to develop digital skills for all.

1. Programme and total number of participants

unibz offers its students (and teaching staff) the opportunity to participate in Short Mobility Programme. This selection refers to the physical participation for the programme:

- European University Cyprus: AI and Cybersecurity: from concept to practice**

Admitted students: 5

Physical mobility: 14-18/19.07.2025

Virtual mobility: before and/or after the physical activity, to be confirmed

In addition to the above-mentioned spots for students, one teaching staff mobility is available.

2. Financial support

To support the period of physical mobility carried out within the programme, a financial contribution is provided.

Students

The contribution is addressed to all students admitted to the programme who will complete the planned physical and virtual mobility.

Individual support
From the 1 st until the 14 th day of mobility: 79 euro per day
Travel grant
Approx. 395 Euro lump sum

The grant may be supplemented by specific contributions to support inclusiveness. Further information will be sent by unibz to the winners of mobility.

Any additional funding for students with special needs relating to health conditions may be allocated by the European Union. The availability of grants for special needs will be notified directly to the winners.

Grants received may be subject to refund in the event of:

- renunciation of the short mobility period (physical and/or virtual)
- cancellation of the mobility period by unibz and/or the partner university due to the student's failure to comply with the provisions of the mobility agreement.
- failure to achieve a minimum of 6 ECTS (free choice or extracurricular).

Teaching staff

For amounts, specifications (duration, number of teaching hours, etc.) and limitations of the teaching staff grant, the rules of the Erasmus programme apply.

All expenses must also be incurred and documented in compliance with the current unibz regulation on missions/business trips.

3. Eligibility criteria

Students

Participation to the programme is open to students of the following disciplines and/or degree programmes:

L-31 and LM-18

To be eligible for short-term physical mobility, it is necessary to consider the maximum number of Erasmus mobility days available for each study cycle, detailed below:

- Cycle I and II (bachelor and Master): 12 months

It is also specified that:

- It is possible to carry out, in the same academic year but not at the same time, one or more Erasmus mobility activities abroad (Study, Traineeship or short mobility/BIP);
- Virtual mobility covered by this Call for Applications is, however, compatible with other international mobility programmes (including Erasmus).

Teaching staff

unibz teaching staff from the Faculty of Engineering must carry out teaching activities agreed with the partners and to be documented in accordance with the Erasmus regulations within the framework of the short mobility/BIP which is the subject of this call for applications.

4. Selection criteria and procedures

An appointed Committee formed by B. Carpentieri, A. Artale, J. Gamper, substitute: Xiaofeng Wang will carry out the selection procedures.

Selection criteria for students:

1. University credits (ECTS) earned: total credits earned divided by those required in the study plan (30%)
2. Grade point average (30%)
3. Motivation letter (40%)

Selection criteria for teaching staff

4. Academic role and seniority (max 20 points)
5. Erasmus+ or international experience (max 20 points)
6. Willingness to actively contribute to the program (max 30 points)
7. Motivation letter (max 30 points)

5. How to apply

Students

The rankings will be drawn up by the Commission and made available by **18 June 2025**.

Winning students/teaching staff must accept/renounce to the mobility through the online procedure (or through any other duly communicated procedure) within **June 19th**, following the instructions that will be provided by unibz.

Successful candidates who do not sign their acceptance by the established deadline will be automatically excluded from the rankings, as ex officio renounced for the present Call.

Vacancies not filled due to non-acceptance or renunciation shall be assigned through the sliding of the ranking list. In this case, the mobility assignment shall be notified to the eligible candidates called as replacement only through a communication to the institutional e-mail address.

6. Recognition of the mobility

Students

The period of international mobility, carried out in its blended mode, is an integral part of the educational pathway and enjoys full academic recognition, on the basis of what has been agreed in advance with the student's Faculty and with the host university through the Learning Agreement for Studies (study plan for the mobility period).

The training activity carried out within the Erasmus short mobility must be recognized within the academic career at unibz through the compilation of the "Learning Agreement for Studies".

The successful completion of the program, both in its physical and virtual parts, awards 6 ECTS (free choice or extracurricular).

Each student is required to:

- submit the relevant documentation attesting the activity carried out (final "After the mobility" document containing the learning outcomes, credits awarded and the dates of the period of physical mobility certified by the partner university).

Teaching staff

At the end of the mobility, teaching staff is required to submit the relevant documentation attesting the teaching hours carried out.

7. Privacy policy

This information is to be considered as an integration of the note provided in compliance with art. 13 of EU Regulation 679 / 2016 - Data Protection Code (DPC) - at the time of enrollment at the Free University of Bozen-

Bolzano which is recalled here in full. Your personal data, collected today for the completion of the selection procedure and possibly additional to those provided at the time of enrollment at the University, are treated in compliance with the aforementioned regulation as well as with current regulations. As a participant in the selection process, your personal data necessary for the publication of the ranking will be published in the online Study Guide of the university together with the ranking points you achieved.
