Standard credit load (per semester) Recommended: 4 courses (12 credit hours)

Maximum: 5 courses (15 credit hours)

English Language Proficiency Requirement

Exchange students are not required to submit an official language certificate, however, we strongly recommend that students have a minimum of 5.5 IELTS with no bands less 5.5 or 70 iBT TOEFL to ensure success in their studies.
