Description of the BIP initiative	<i>"Leadership: Understanding Group Dynamics" will provide a typical Training Group (T-Group) setting, which is a structured experiential learning setting, designed to enhance participants’ understanding of group dynamics, interpersonal processes, authority, foundations of collaboration and self-awareness. Within this unstructured small-group context (15 participants/group; two groups), learning emerges from the direct examination of behaviour and interaction as they occur in the “here and now.” Participants actively engage in observation, feedback, and reflection</i>
