Contents Summary	The professional internship in the second year allows students to move from participant observation to socio-pedagogical practice. Under the guidance of qualified tutors, they independently take on practical tasks and thus expand their knowledge and operational skills. The aim is the systematic development of practical and operational skills, the acquisition of reflective professionalism and active collaboration within (multi)professional teams.
