Contents Summary	The professional internship in the third year of study allows students to deepen and broaden their experience in another practical field of so-cial education. Supervised by their mentors, they plan, im-plement, document, reflect on, and evaluate their peda-gogical interventions in a field of social education. The goal is not only the sys-tematic acquisition of prac-tice-oriented competencies, the development of reflective professionalism, and active collaboration in (multi-)professional teams, but also the methodologically sound (research-based) handling of research questions relevant to the field of practice.

Course Topics	- Acquisition of knowledge in the chosen socio-educational field. - Analysing target groups, tasks, methods and institutional framework conditions. - Planning, implementation and evaluation of socio-educational tasks with professional supervision. - Application of methods for planning, documentation and pedagogical evaluation. - Consolidating the ability to combine theory and practice in real-life situations. - Reflection on one's own professional identity, the competences acquired and the areas in which there is still potential for development. - Working on a research question arising from the practical field (practical/action research) - Composing a written reflection report

Learning Strategies - Students are able to de-velop personal improve-ment strategies. - They develop independ-ence in learning and in critically reflecting on pedagogical work. - They develop strategies for maintaining a continu-ous connection between theory, research, and prac-tice.
