- to register for the exam of a theoretical course (e.g. History of contemporary art, History of design) students must have a certified B1 level in the language in which the course is offered;
- students can register for the exam of a practical course (e.g. Drawing, Studio, Project, Typography and Graphics...) also without the B1 certification in the course's language.

<u>From the 2nd year onwards</u>, students must have a certified B1 level in the language in which the course is offered in order to register for any degree course

Additional prerequisites/propaedeuticities are indicated in the syllabi of the offered courses.

TECHNICAL WORKSHOP COURSES FOR BOTH CURRICULA (DESIGN AND ART)

Workshop courses are offered for which no credits are awarded. To access the individual workshops, students must attend the safety course required by current regulations (**Work Safety – Machinery Hazard – Chemical Risk**). During the first semester, students participate in the workshop courses offered within the "Warm-Up" project. **This block of introductory courses is mandatory** in order to access the specialised workshop courses. Starting from the **second semester**, students choose and attend **at least two specialised workshop courses**.

ADDITIONAL EDUCATIONAL OBLIGATIONS

The Additional Learning Obligations are assigned if any weakness is found in your basic education.

You must fulfilled Additional Learning Obligations in the third language if you have not certified level B1 in the third language.

In addition, if you have been admitted to the BA and have achieved a score of less than 48 points in the selection procedure, you will receive Additional Learning Obligations.

The Additional Learning Obligations are defined before the beginning of the academic year in the Bachelor Study Council and published in the syllabi of the WUP Design and WUP Art projects.

The Additional Learning Obligations are met by passing an exam.
